

CMP Monthly Report January 21, 2017

Overview:

This report will contain the activities from mid-November to mid-January.

Latest workings:

Continued my research a benefit with membership for attract and retain members. I misunderstood what the possibility could entail. This benefit is one free event provided as part of the individual's membership. The benefit has been identified as a "complimentary benefit." It will only be applied to a limited category of membership levels. These levels are those who are not already getting a discount. We got it up and running in a beta test mode. Peggy H and I tested and it seems to be working. I have decided that only two activities (Academic Coursework and PINRA) will be the only two free complimentary benefits. This came from research that I did on how much time it would take for me to process Independent Study (IS).

WA is set up to handle the complimentary benefit event. With the help of Peggy H, I have the Complimentary Benefit webpage. I am working on the basic information about it on that page. Currently it is blank.

Members are still not following Sign-In sheet instructions. I received a Sign-In sheet that was all over the place. Thank you to Kim and Cyndy (PDC) for typing it in to assist me. After attending a workshop, I found a process to handle my struggle to read their member ID numbers and how their last names are spelled. A file .CSV will be sent to non-SCRID hosted workshops where the participant will be required to sign the RID Sign-In sheet and the hosting entity to log into the CSV file their member ID and last name. For the SCRID workshops, it was suggested that I obtain the spelling of their last names and RID member IDs from WA to assist me. I will also need the Sign-In sheet where the host may have crossed out or made a note on who did not meet the requirements for earning the Certificate.

I found another CMP sponsor using Google Forms to handle the activity forms (PINRA, AC and workshop). I worked to get a PINRA form up on our website and tested it. I soon learned there was a drawback. There isn't a way to notify me that someone filled in the form. The other CMP sponsor sets an alert on their phone to go check the Google Forms often. I believe that will be a little too much work for me. I have PINRA, workshop and AC forms in Google Forms just in case I change my mind.

I updated the workshop page (November 2016) to say who is required to fill out which form:

- Sponsor form is filled out by the hosting entity
- Instructor form is filled out by the presenter

I updated the PINRA page (November 2016) with links to documents to obtain verification of attendance for the participant.

Received an email in November from Jenna Cassell (President of Sign Enhancers, Inc.). She would like a collaboration of Sign Enhancers, Inc. and SCRID CMP in handling IS

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for some of their products. In the months of Oct/Nov 2016, she received (from previous products) 75 requests. We talked about the products and the IS which she pre-filled for the members. After our discussion, I realized that SCRID does not have the resources to process these IS CEUs. Her guess was roughly 2 – 10 a month, not sure if every month. The product of the work provided would require me to view at least 2 videos (pre- and post) then a write up.
